by training competitive researchers.










iCARE-2 2018 - Results

3 types of fellowships



REINTEGRATION:

To favour the return of Italian scientists after a successful research experience abroad

OUTGOING:

To support fellows interested in a research experience in a competitive laboratory outside of Italy





Focus on training on SCIENCE



in the field of **CANCER RESEARCH**

BOTTOM UP approach.

Any project applied to CANCER in any field can be submitted.

INTERDISCIPLINARITY is welcome, since CANCER can be studied from different points of view.

iCARE-2 program adopts **SEVERAL STRATEGIES** to train fellows in transferable skills:

- ✓ Hosting Institutions are requested to provide fellows with training opportunities
- ✓ A **dedicated budget** (€ 1800/year) to be used for meetings and/or training events
- ✓ Advertisement of **publicly available training events** on transferable skills
- ✓ iCARE-2 meetings in Milan

Applicants

must be EXPERIENCED RESEARCHERS

i.e. at the time of the submission deadline, applicants MUST either be in possession of a doctoral degree or have at least four years of full-time equivalent research experience after the degree which formally allowed them to embark on a doctorate









Mobility rules

FOR ALL FELLOWSHIPS

Applicants must not have resided or carried out their main activity in the Country of the Hosting Institution for more than 12 months in the 3 years prior to the Call deadline

FOR OUTGOING FELLOWSHIPS

Applicants must have legally resided/worked in Italy for at least 3 out of the last 4 years prior to the Call deadline





Hosting Institution

Each application will be assigned to reviewers







Three reviewers per fellowship application

Each application is evaluated in an

independent manner by

3 reviewers with specific expertise

in the research area of the application.

Step 1

Admissibility & eligibility check



Step 2

Assignment to reviewers



Step 3

Evaluation and ranking



Formal requirements of the applicant and of the Hosting Institution will be verified

Each application will be assigned to reviewers

Each reviewer will evaluate and give a score to the proposal. The average of the 3 scores will decide the position in the preliminary ranking







Step 4

Notification of preliminary results



- the top 15 applications will be the FINALISTS
- the following 10 applications will be RESERVISTS



Step 5

Interviews and ethics review

FINALISTS and RESERVISTS will undergo:

- A **phone interview** with two of the three reviewers
- An ethics review of their application



Ethics Self Assessment!!!

We ask information about the procedures.





Step 4

Notification of preliminary results



- the top 15 applications will be the FINALISTS
- the following 10 applications will be RESERVISTS



Step 5

Interviews and ethics review



Step 6

Notification of award

FINALISTS and RESERVISTS will undergo:

- a **phone interview** with two of the three reviewers
- an ethics review of their application


Finalists with positive interviews and ethics review will be awarded an iCARE-2 fellowship.

- Training opportunities

Research plan

- Focused on CANCER
- Agreed with the Head of the hosting lab
- Feasible

CV of the applicant


- Commitment to cancer research
- Education and professional experience

- Contact the Hosting Institution
- Collect all the documents and information
- Have your proposal read by a colleague
- Spend the needed time to fill in the "bureaucratic" part of the application








